INFRALOBO E.M. ATTENDS 1ST EDITION OF NEXT.MOV – SMART REGION SUMMIT



Last May 18 and 19 saw the 1st edition of the Next.Mov – Smart Region Summit, held at the Autódromo Internacional do Algarve racetrack.
